Dumpster Day–Saturday, April 15, 2023 - 8 a.m. - 2 p.m.

The Village will accept the following items for the fees indicated at a dumpster located at the Village Maintenance Shop at 15866 West Judd St. (below Impact Gel).

Items can be dropped off between 8 a.m. & 2 p.m. Please do not leave refuse at the dumpster before or after the scheduled hours. **The dumpster and appliance and furniture disposal is for Village of Ettrick residents only.**

- ❖ Refrigerators, dehumidifiers, freezers, air conditioners, stoves, washers and dryers, water heaters, furnaces and computers - **\$15.00**
- ❖ Microwaves, small TV's & VCR's and computer monitors - **\$10.00**
- ❖ Large TV's (32 inch +) and sofa beds - **\$20.00**
- ❖ Couches, chairs, mattresses and other furniture- **\$10.00**
- ❖ Small chairs- \$5.00
- ❖ 8 foot (or shorter) fluorescent bulbs- **\$1.00**

Metal, tail pipes, mufflers, wire, window glass, concrete, wood under (4) feet in length and small amounts of building materials will be accepted at 6¢/pound or \$120.00/ton. Individual pricing will be determined by the attendant in charge.

Paint is not accepted at the dumpster, but you may bring paint cans containing small amounts of dried paint.

Payment must be made before disposal and **checks should be made payable to Village of Ettrick**. Full truckloads must present a weight slip.

Used oil will be accepted in proper containers.



DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE

Village residents are required to use Village of Ettrick garbage bags for disposal of their garbage. Residential dumpsters are not allowed in the village. Bags are available at the Village Office and Ettrick Express Mart for \$3.00/bag. **Tri-City Sanitation provides curbside garbage pick-up every Wednesday. Have your garbage at the curb by 7 a.m. Please have bags tied shut or they will not be picked up.** Commercial businesses must contract with Tri-City Sanitation for pick up service and dumpster rental at 1-715-538-4311.

NO GARBAGE OR TRASH BURNING is allowed in the Village.
During a holiday week garbage will still be picked up on Wednesday, as scheduled, unless the holiday falls on Wednesday.

Village Ordinance #700-D regulates open burning including outdoor fire-pits/fireplaces. Owners of outdoor fireplaces are required to have your fire pit inspected and get a one-time permit. There is no cost for the permit. To make an appointment for inspection contact Courtney Kotlarz at 608-484-0056.



RECYCLING



All residents are encouraged to recycle. Attached is a recycling pick up calendar and an information sheet on recyclable items and directions for preparing them. **Curbside pick up of recyclables is provided by Hilltopper Refuse every other Thursday.**

One recycling bin is provided at no charge to each household and must be left at the residence if you move or you will be charged \$25.00 for a replacement bin.

Extra recycling should be in a paper or plastic bag or laundry basket on top of or alongside your recycling bin. If a **recycling bin** is not at the curb or your recyclables are

not properly prepared your recycling will not be picked up. If you have any questions, contact Hilltopper Refuse at 608-783-6727.

When mowing, please do not blow grass into the street. The grass clippings plug the water collecting system, costing the Village of Ettrick money. Please remove all junk and trash from your property. The Village Maintenance Department will pick up yard waste and small branches periodically during the spring clean-up in the month of April. The lawn waste must be bagged and the branches tied in 4 foot bundles and placed at the curb. Lawn waste and small branches will also be picked up periodically after summer storms by the Village Maintenance Department. **YARD WASTE ONLY** may be deposited at the village yard waste dump site behind Impact Gel, but no furniture, scrap or garbage is allowed. **If residents continue to leave anything but yard waste we will have to close this site.** Do not plant new trees on the boulevard without permission from the Village Board. Please notify the Village of diseased or dead trees.

BUILDING PERMITS

Before starting any building or remodeling projects, windows, accessory buildings or roofing, contact Village Clerk Jane Jensen at 608-525-5445 for a building permit application. **The application must be submitted, along with drawings of the proposed project, to the Village Board, for approval at their meeting on the 1st Tuesday of the month. Projects cannot begin before final approval and issuance of the permit.** Before beginning demolition projects, it may be necessary to obtain a demolition permit from the D.N.R. A dumpster is necessary to dispose of materials for all building, remodeling, roofing and demolition projects. For any new construction you must contact the Trempealeau Co. Ordinance #105 establishing ATV, UTV and Golf Cart Regulations

Village Ordinance #105 regulates the operation of ATV's, UTV's and Golf Carts on Village Streets. Operators of ATV's UTV's and Golf Carts must be at least 16 years of age. SMV signs are required and available at the Village Office for \$10.00 each. Penalty for unauthorized use will be

\$50.00 per occurrence plus all other fees and penalties including Attorney's fees.
